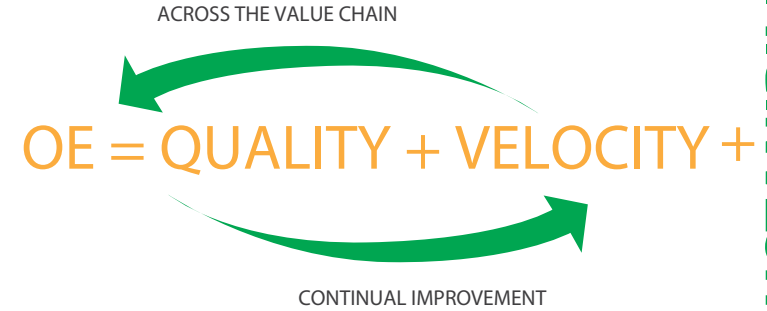
For example, an aluminium door and window manufacturing facility conducted SMED (Lean tool) events to reduce the amount of paint wasted per changeover from 50 gallons per day to less than 10 gallons. Paint disposal costs dropped by as much as Rs. 1.4 Cr annually! and paint and solvent disposal were reduced by more than 40 percent - a very Green impact! Using a cross-functional team, they identified waste elimination opportunities that impacted both the bottom line and the environment!

Lean to Green Manufacturing.....the leading similarity between the benefits of lean and the benefits of green is waste, and so it makes perfect sense that in order to achieve higher levels of environmental performance, your organization must first adopt the principles and practices of lean manufacturing and then superimpose Green thinking on Lean thinking!

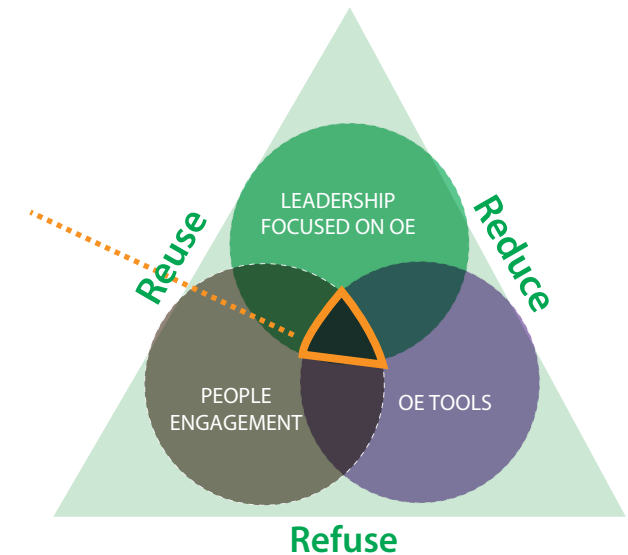
